*importanti informazioni dalla scuola – a meta strada attraverso il termine 2!***National Walk Safely To School Day**

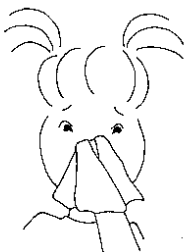
This Friday 22 May 2015, is National Walk Safely to School Day. Walk Safely to School Day aims to:
