What a great day!



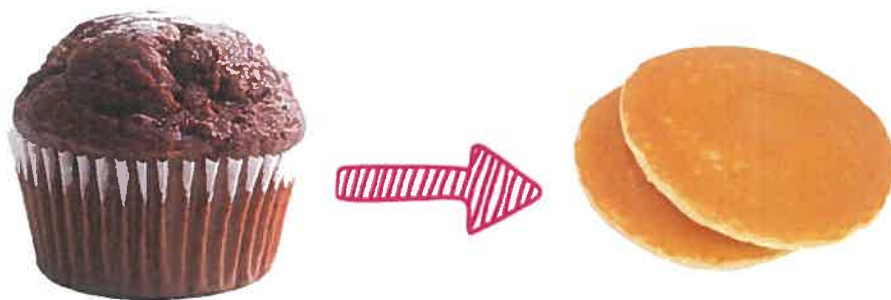


Healthy doesn't = expensive
