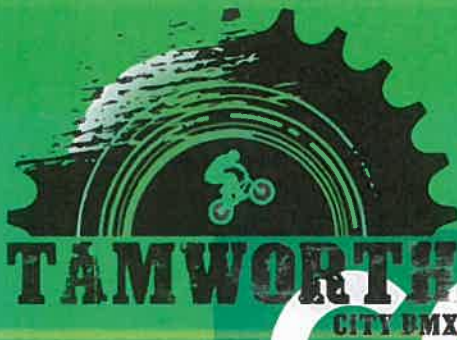

What to bring: your BMX, dirt jumper, or mountain bike. We have some bikes and gear available to loan.

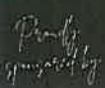
